
### JTP GROUNDWORK – Overview

JTP GROUNDWORK is a service delivered by the Just Transition Platform (JTP). The platform, set up by the European Commission, provides a single access point to expert knowledge and support for EU regions which receive funding from the Just Transition Fund.

JTP GROUNDWORK works with regions where the transition to a sustainable economy is particularly demanding. Via JTP GROUNDWORK, the European Commission provides capacity-building support to regions to implement their Territorial Just Transition Plans (TJTPs), which define how they will use the funding.

JTP GROUNDWORK delivers tailored support, based on the needs that regions have identified.
